to start work as soon as possible. The role is scheduled for 40 hours a week. The work time is flexible and work happens from the applicant's home office, which can be located anywhere in the world. Our infrastructure is based on 4 large hypervisors with about 50 KVM-based virtual machines primarily running on Debian 8, deployed using SaltStack. The tools we make use of include:

- » Nginx and Apache
- » Postfix, Dovecot, SpamAssassin, amavisd, ClamAV
- » Gitlab and Gitlab CI
- » Gerrit, Bugzilla, Jenkins
- » AskBot, ownCloud, MediaWiki, Etherpad, Piwik, etc.

Skills we seek include:

- » experience in administrating and maintaining a 24/7 production system
- » a good and pro-active communicator, fluent in English
- » sensible towards data privacy-related topics
- » ability to act quickly on critical security updates
- » expertise with DNS, SSL certificates and domain registration
- » mentoring skills to onboard new volunteers
