 - The conference will take place in Boğaziçi University (BOUN), İstanbul.
 - Address: Albert Long Hall, Güney Kampüs, 34342 Bebek/İstanbul TÜRKİYE
 - Capacities in the main venue: 479, 86, 20; foy area: 250 (cocktails), 80 (meals)
 - Coming from Sabiha Gökçen Airport takes 45-60 minutes, and coming from Atatürk Airport takes less than Sabiha Gökçen with metro.
 - Reaching the venue from public transportation stop is taking 5-10 minutes by walking.

 - Almost all areas in the venue are wheelchair-accessible. BOUN is so sensitive in this topic.
- The conference itself is on 3 days, but their is an extra day before the conference dedicated to community meetings, this should be taken into account into the proposal.

- We are planning everything for 4 days, so yes, we have taken the community day into account.
- Providing canvas, projectors and rooms for two to five tracks in parallel, for a total of approximately 300 visitors, are required. Please let us know if your venue fulfills these requirements.
